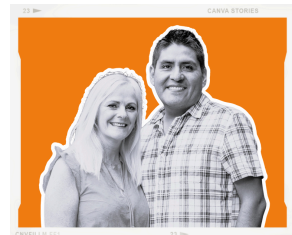
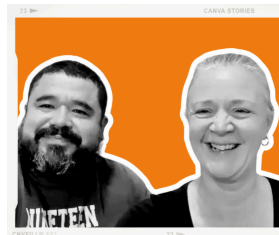
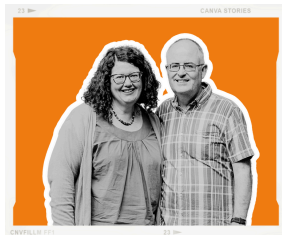


IRISH PRAYER LINK JULY 2025



PRAYER POINTS:

1 Pray for the Step teams in Ecuador and Peru this month. Give thanks for the five young people from Northern Ireland on these teams. Pray for safe travel for everyone and for good health and safety in the countries.

2 Pray for Daniel Allen as he gets settled back into ministry in Bolivia with the international school.

3 Pray for missionaries from Latin America currently serving in the UK. Give thanks for their work to help our churches and pray for excellent fellowship amongst believers cross-culturally.

4 Today, Suz Crothers is helping to run a 'pyjama night' for the teenage girls that she disciples through the Vale Project in Brazil. It will be 24 hours of fun, food, games, worship and testimonies. Pray for a blessed time.

5 This week, Latin Link will be setting up a stand at Keswick in Portstewart. Pray for good engagement and an encouraging week.

6 Continue to pray for Margo Huamán's prison ministry, that God would speak into the hearts of the women and draw them to Himself.

7 Continue to pray for Paul Turner's Arrow leadership courses in Peru. From 10–13 July, Paul will be leading their third intensive class. Pray that God would speak to each of the 16 leaders taking part.

8 Today, Emma and Fredi Rivero will receive their first Step Team in Moyobamba. Pray as they arrange their projects, for good relationships amongst team members, and for a great connection with the team and host church. Pray for safety for the team in travel.

PRAYER POINTS:

9 Until 11 July, Paul and Suz Crothers will be hosting a Holiday Bible Club for the children at the Vale project. A group from the Korean church in Sao Paulo are coming to partner with them. Pray that they will work well together in sharing the gospel.

10 Throughout this month, Laura Sanlon is continuing with research trips each weekend to the Republic of Ireland. Please pray as she analyses her data and writes up the findings. She hopes to finish by 31 July.

11 Pray that the Step teams would be a blessing in the communities in which they are serving in Ecuador and Peru.

12 Please pray for Ruth Turner who is leading a workshop at a mission event for ladies in a large church in Lima, where she will be talking about how to prepare missionaries well before they go to the mission field.

13 Pray for Fredi Rivero as he heads out today to the indigenous community in Mazamari to train pastors. Pray for safety in travel and for clarity in teaching for the week he will spend there.

14 Please continue to pray for the health of Latin Link members past and present, and for peace throughout times of illness.

15 Pray that Margo and Eduardo Huamán would continue to see growth in the spiritual lives of the students in their Bible courses.

16 Pray for wisdom, creativity and encouragement for Esther Stansfield, as she heads up the Latin Link Britain and Ireland mobilisation team.

17 Pray for more opportunities to engage with young people in Northern Ireland. Pray that they would be challenged to consider their responsibility to be involved in global mission.

18 Please pray for each member of the Latin Link international member care team as they lead specific areas forward, and for wisdom for Ruth Turner as she coordinates member care across Latin Link.

19 Pray for Latin Link members past and present who are attending the Keswick Convention in England this year. Pray for a refreshing and spirit-filled time, of little distraction and full focus on God.

20 Rose Wade asks for prayer for her team and local ministry in Guatemala, as they undergo a key period of transition. Pray for wisdom and discernment during each stage of the process.

21 Continue to pray for Daniel Allen's exploration of other ways to serve in Bolivia, especially in Mission Mobilisation.



PRAYER POINTS:

22 Please pray for God's wisdom with Laura Sanlon's chaplaincy work in the Royal Victoria Hospital and the NI Hospice every Wednesday. Please pray for wisdom as she visits patients and families, and as she connects with chaplaincy colleagues each week.

23 Continue to pray for Latin Link's fundraising opportunities, and for fresh ideas to generate funds.

24 Margo and Eduardo Huamán ask for prayer for the political situation in Lima at present. Pray that the government would gain control over the crime situation, as extortionists continue to harass and kill those who are not paying up.

25 Pray that Latin Link would be able to have a greater involvement in the Republic of Ireland. Pray for connections to be made and opportunities to engage with individuals and churches beyond Northern Ireland.

26 Daniel Allen asks for prayer for the political and economic situation in Bolivia. The country faces an uncertain future, and many are struggling to have their basic needs met as prices rise. Pray that God would work in this situation and that a resolution would be found quickly as the country prepares for an election in August.

27 Pray for wisdom and discernment for Paul and Ruth Turner as they mentor other leaders and mission workers.

28 Today, Paul and Suz Crothers are receiving a mission team from 2nd Comber Presbyterian Church. They will spend two weeks working on the Vale Project: one week doing construction/manual work, and the other doing holiday Bible club activities. Pray for the travel and logistics on both sides. Pray that this trip will be a real blessing to all and that lives would be changed and impacted.

29 Pray for rest and respite for Latin Link members after a busy few months. Pray that God will keep them close to Him in daily prayer and bible reading.

30 Pray for the Shalom family camp starting today, which will end on 1 August. Pray for Ruth McKee as she manages this, and for the attending Shalom families as they get some well-deserved respite in the countryside.

31 Pray that lives will be changed at the Shalom family camp today, and that all attending will be thoroughly blessed by the Lord.
