

# IRISH PRAYER LINK SEPTEMBER 2025



## PRAYER POINTS:

1 Pray for Ruth Turner over the next few days as she visits Peru sent team member, Elvira Lezameta, who is working in church planting in a small town located an hour from Salamanca in Spain.

2 Laura Sanlon is currently taking a break. Pray for a good time of rest before the new season.

3 This month, the Rivero family will be welcoming Grace, a Strider, who will be working with them in Peru for six months. Pray for her safe arrival, and her time of adjustment living with a family from the local church.

4 Pray for Latin Link members who may be feeling lonely or missing family.

5 Pray for the various Bible study groups that Margo and Eduardo Huamán host. Pray that people will continue to grow and learn in these groups, maintain the discipline of study and not let other things distract them.

6 Rose Wade asks for prayer for safety as she travels around Guatemala City. There has recently been seismic activity in different parts of the country, with several earthquake tremors in June that have now calmed. Pray for families whose simple homes were damaged and for those living in fear.

7 Today, Suzanne Crothers' dad is arriving in Brazil for a two-week visit. Pray for safe travels, and enjoyable time, and for him to witness Paul and Suz's work first hand.

8 Pray for Ruth Turner and members of Latin Link's International Core team who are gathering for their annual in-person meetings in Malaga (8-13 September). Pray for wisdom and discernment for the core team as they make decisions. The team will also be able to see Paula and Matias Rigau and their ministry among the large migration community there.

9 Pray for Fredi Rivero who will be travelling to the town of Yurimaguas with Mision610 and medical mission "Rise and Shine" this week (8-11 September) to do evangelism training and a medical campaign.

10 Pray for the Ireland Action Group as they meet this month to plan for the upcoming year. Give thanks for all members of the group and their willingness to serve.

11 Pray for Strider David Gregg as he makes final preparations to go to Ecuador until February 2026 to work with a foundation called Niños con Destino (Children with a Future). Pray for David as he travels on 15 September, as he settles in and adapts to a new culture, giving thanks that he already has a good level of Spanish.

12 After her break, pray for Laura Sanlon as she resumes her routine activities and meetings, alongside the research stages of interviews and data analysis for her project on diaspora church communities.

13 Pray for Heather Cochrane, Ireland Coordinator, as she speaks today about Latin Link at a ladies' breakfast in Coleraine.

14 Pray for Paul Turner as he spends time in Arequipa as the International School and Shalom celebrates their anniversaries. Pray for Paul as he will have various meetings during these days and as he gives speeches at the different ceremonies.

15 Today, Ruth McKee and her team are celebrating the Shalom Centre's anniversary in Arequipa. Praise God for his faithfulness and his provision over the past 22 years.

16 Pray for past Latin Link members and missionaries. Pray for God's continued direction in their life.

17 Pray for the ministry of Youth for Christ in Guatemala, where Rose Wade serves. The team is currently undergoing a change in leadership. Give thanks for Carlos (ex-director) who served Youth for Christ for the last number of years. Pray for God's guidance as the organisation makes important decisions about its future.

18 Continue to pray for the health of Latin Link members past and present. Pray that those who are ill will know God's all-sufficient grace and strength.

19 Pray for Daniel Allen in Bolivia, that God would sustain him in his role at the international school. Give thanks for the opportunity he has to teach from the Bible.

20 Pray that God will continue to work in the hearts of those recently returned from summer Step teams.

21 Pray for fresh ideas for fundraising for Latin Link, and increased partnership with local churches.

22 Give thanks for the Inspire events that Latin Link has held across Northern Ireland. Praise God for the interest shown in global mission and pray that this would increase through more Inspire events to come.

23 Pray that God would keep Latin Link members disciplined and excited to walk with the Lord daily, in Bible reading and prayer.

24 Paul and Suzanne Crothers give thanks that their project (Vale) was chosen by the Keswick Convention in Portstewart as the recipients of the gift offering this year. The offering will help provide resources and gospel access for children with additional learning needs.

25 Pray for Latin Link's Head of Mobilisation, Esther Stansfield, as she plans for upcoming events in the autumn. Pray for wisdom and God's guidance.

26 Pray for Paul and Ruth Turner as they travel to Moyobamba to visit the Rivero family. Pray that they will be an encouragement to Emma, Fredi and the children and that God would give them wisdom in their conversations.

27 Pray for Margo Huamán and her weekly prison visits, that God would use the Bible studies and time together to speak into the hearts of the women.

28 Pray for Strider David Gregg as he settles into life in Ecuador. Pray for him as he seeks to minister to children from challenging backgrounds and to build relationships to share the gospel.

29 Give thanks for Latin Link's Member Care group, and for all the work they do in supporting missionaries to look after their mental health. Praise God for their skills in this area, and that he'll continue to bless others through it.
