6 This is Ruth McKee's last month working at Shalom in Arequipa, Peru. Pray for all the emotions involved in finishing up and that it will be a time to give thanks for all God has done. Pray for Ruth as she says goodbye at an event at Shalom and at another event for church friends.

7 Pray for the Casa de Dios church where Eduardo and Margo Huamán serve near Lima, Peru, Pray that God will encourage the believers and help them to share their faith with those in the community.

8 Pray for Paul and Suz Crothers in Brazil in their roles as coordinators of the teenage boys' and girls' work. Pray for good leadership and creativity in planning and organising activities and events.

9 Laura Sanlon would value prayer as she focuses this month on trying to complete the analysis of the data for her Guided Research Project. Please pray for wisdom and insight as she carries out this process.
