JUNE 2026



PRAYER POINTS:

- 1 Pray for all Latin Link missionaries in this new month ahead – pray that God would grant them wisdom, patience and strength in each day.
- 2 Pray for Ruth McKee as she takes a holiday during the first two weeks of June. Pray for rest and refreshment as she then spends time with friends in Lima before leaving Peru on 29 June.
- 3 Paul and Suzanne Crothers give thanks for a large food donation that the Vale Project recently received from a Christian school in the city. This will cover most of the food needs at the project in 2026.
- 4 Pray that God would provide Daniel Allen with ministry opportunities to serve him, alongside the work Daniel is already doing in school. Pray that God might begin to show Daniel and Micaela where he would have them serve in the long-term.
- 5 Give thanks for the Irish Action Group's newest members – Andrew and Susie – who have recently organised and completed fundraising activities for Latin Link. Susie's husband, Jamie, ran the Belfast marathon and Andrew cycled 140km on an exercise bike in Ards Shopping Centre. Give thanks for their efforts and enthusiasm.
- 6 Please continue to pray for the paperwork of the Rivero family's foster baby, Liam. Pray that these administrative details will be sorted before the family's home leave in December.
- 7 Pray for the second round of the presidential elections in Peru today, held between two controversial candidates. Pray that the leaders will be able to bring some stability to the country.
- 8 Pray for those who are thinking about applying for Paul and Ruth Turner's next Arrow leadership class starting in October.

9 Continue to pray for Jo Jowett, the chair of Latin Link's trustees. Pray for wisdom and guidance for Jo and the trustees as they make important decisions for Latin Link Britain & Ireland.

10 Laura Sanlon asks for prayer as she pushes to complete her Guided Research Project. Please pray she will get it finished by the end of this month.

11 Pray for wisdom, discernment and grace for Paul and Ruth Turner as they mentor individuals, attend to people pastorally and participate in (and lead) various teams.

12 Pray for Paul Turner in his role as Latin Link Peru Team leader, and especially over the next few days as he leads a time of retreat with the Peru leadership team.

13 Rose Wade requests prayer for the continued planning of her youth ministry course and for opportunities that are opening up to deliver training in other parts of Guatemala.

14 Continue to give thanks for the Irish Action Group, and everything that they do behind the scenes.

15 Pray for the economic situations of all countries where Latin Link missionaries serve, particularly in light of geopolitical tensions in Iran, Israel, Gaza and Ukraine. Pray for peace and healing of our world.

16 Continue to pray for Laura Sanlon as she visits patients in the Royal Victoria Hospital and the NI Hospice every Wednesday. Thank God for her opportunities to talk, read scripture and pray with some patients. Pray that others will be open to the Lord.

17 Pray for Shirley McCammon (chair of the Irish Action Group) and her husband, Ian, as they speak at a supporting church this evening about the work of Latin Link.

18 Pray for wisdom and a good time of sharing for the Latin Link International Member Care Team, who will meet today, led by Ruth Turner.

19 Give thanks for the two online Latin Link prayer meetings that are held monthly on a Friday evening and Sunday afternoon. Give thanks for these dedicated supporters who gather to pray for Latin Link missionaries.

20 Pray that God would continue to provide opportunities for Daniel Allen to support students in Carachipampa School on a one-to-one basis. Many students come from difficult situations at home and need this support.

21 Suzanne Crothers' sister and her sister's boyfriend will be visiting Recife in the last couple of weeks of June. Pray that this visit will be impactful for them as they see the Crothers' work first hand.

22 Today, Fredi Rivero is going to Yurimaguas and the community of Shucushyacu with Mission 610 to support a medical ministry, including vision checks and outreach. To get to the community he has to travel by boat for several hours; please pray for this journey.

23 Margo and Eduardo Huamán ask for prayer for the Bible study groups that they run. Pray that the students would continue to grow in their faith and use what they are learning to teach others.

24 Pray for Terry Lockyer, the leader of the Latin Link Britain and Ireland team. Pray that God would give him great wisdom, discernment and encouragement.

25 Paul and Ruth Turner praise God for how well the current Arrow class is engaged. Pray that God would continue to do deep work in the hearts of the 16 leaders.

26 Pray for more Bible-believing and Christ-centred churches across Latin America, Spain, UK and Ireland.

27 Pray for Latin Link's Reading office staff, for all who work hard to keep the organisation running. Give thanks for their commitment and contribution.

28 Continue to pray for Laura Sanlon as she leads various planning meetings, including for the Lausanne Northern Ireland/Ireland Steering Group. Pray that Laura will be effective in these meetings.

29 Pray for Ruth McKee as she leaves Peru today to return to N. Ireland after 12 years of faithful service.
