

# IRISH PRAYER LINK JULY 2026



## PRAYER POINTS:

1 Pray for Laura Sanlon today as she begins helping with her church's sports camp outreach. Pray for great attendance and seeds sown.

2 Rose Wade gives thanks for the participants of the Pilares youth ministry training course which started in May. Pray for them as they attend training, do homework and put their learning into practice.

3 Pray for Latin Link's presence at Keswick, Portstewart from 4-10 July. Pray for the volunteers, including members of the Irish Action Group, who will be at the stand. Pray for great conversations and interest.

4 Praise God for all the farewell parties and special times with friends that Ruth McKee was able to enjoy before leaving Peru. Join Ruth in praising God for the opportunity to live and serve him in Peru and for all she has learned.

5 Pray for Daniel Allen, his colleagues and students as they have their winter break this month. Pray that all will return to school refreshed for the second half of the year.

6 Pray for Belfast after the recent riots in June - immigrants were targeted after a Sudanese man attacked another man from Northern Ireland. Pray for sustained peace, safety and the spread of God's love against hate. Pray for those living in fear.

7 From today until 12 July, Paul and Suz Crothers (in Brazil) are receiving a church group from São Paulo to help with the Vale Project Holiday Bible Club. Pray that God will bless this week and the different activities planned.

8 Emma and Fredi Rivero request prayer for their emerging project in the village of Santa Catalina near Moyobamba, Peru. They are currently getting to know the village, its authorities and families. Pray for good relationships to be formed and for guidance and clarity as they consider how to invest in village life.

9 Pray for Ruth Turner as she leads a training course today for Latin Link members about how to do a debrief.

10 Pray for Paul Turner this weekend as he leads the third intensive (online) for his 4th Arrow Leadership Class. Pray that the leaders will engage well with each topic and that God would be at work.

11 Pray for the Step team arriving in Peru this week. They will be working alongside two churches, one in Lima and one in Trujillo. Pray that God would speak into their lives, for their safety, and that God would use them to bless and encourage others.

12 Give thanks that some girls in the children's home in Guatemala City have been asking Rose Wade and her colleagues for more discipleship. Praise God for this interest and pray for wisdom on how to facilitate this well.

13 Give thanks for the 12 years that Ruth McKee spent in Peru. Give thanks for her work at Shalom, in Arequipa, and for the valuable contribution she made to so many families over the years. Pray for Shalom as the work continues.

14 Pray for Margo Huamán in Lima, Peru, as she continues to visit ladies in prison. Pray she would be an encouragement and blessing to them as they face many challenges in their daily lives.

15 Paul and Suz Crothers give thanks for a generous gift from Latin Link friends in the UK, allowing them to install a new water tank at the Vale project. The old tanks were 25 years old and in need of replacing! Praise God for faithful and generous supporters.

16 Tomorrow, Laura Sanlon will be leading a seminar on her research at the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies. Pray for Laura's preparation and an engaging session.

17 Tomorrow, Rose Wade will be facilitating an all-day training for the Pilares course. Pray for wisdom in planning and that the participants attend.

18 Pray for Ruth Turner and her Peru missionary care team today as they host an event for pastors who have missionaries in the field, focused on mental health and wellbeing.

19 Daniel Allen requests prayer for Bolivia - protests against the government are causing roadblocks, especially on highways between cities and in La Paz, where there has been a lot of tension. Pray for peace.

20 Please pray for the health of current and retired Latin Link members, including those in pain. Pray for comfort, strength, and true joy in times of suffering.

21 Pray for Ruth McKee as she settles back into life in N.Ireland after serving in Peru for 12 years. Pray for a time of rest, processing and grieving for what she has left behind in Peru.

# PRAYER POINTS:

22 Pray for the Bible Committee at the international school where Daniel Allen serves as they consider how best to reach out to students' parents.

23 Continue to pray for the paperwork of the Rivero family's foster son, Liam. The family is looking forward to travelling to the UK in December and need to ensure everything is in place for Liam's care in Peru during their time away.

24 Margo and Eduardo Huamán ask for prayer for some young people in their church, Casa de Dios, who are struggling with their spiritual lives. Pray that God would draw near to them and they would be encouraged in their faith.

25 Pray for Latin Link missionaries missing home or family - pray for God's comfort and friendships in their serving countries.

26 From 2-15 August, Paul and Suz Crothers are hosting a mission team from Paul's home church, Sloan Street Presbyterian (Lisburn). Pray for Paul and Suz in the lead up to their arrival as they seek to get everything organised.

27 Continue to pray for Laura Sanlon's chaplaincy work, as she visits patients in Royal Victoria Hospital and the Hospice each week.

28 Continue to pray for Daniel Allen and his wife, Micaela, as they adjust to married life together. Praise God for the blessing of their marriage.

29 Pray for Ruth McKee's health - physical, emotional and spiritual as she continues to settle back into life in N. Ireland.

30 Rose Wade requests prayer for the girls in the children's home with whom she works. This month they have been exploring in more depth the life of Jesus. Help Rose and her colleagues to communicate the life-changing gospel.

31 From 1-2 August, Rose Wade will be delivering youth ministry training in the department of San Marcos (Guatemala). Pray that plans come together, for individuals to sign up, travel arrangements for the six-hour bus journey, for good language skills, and a fruitful, God-honouring time.
